COURSE BRIEF:

ZIMA's new course in Film Making is designed to give a Film/TV aspirant an extensive training in Film Making, spread over 12 months.

The lectures are structured around classic and contemporary films. This course covers the examination of current storytelling trends, terminology, and workflow, and includes the practical application of latest and emerging technologies.

The course is divided into 144 classroom sessions, 48 film appreciation sessions & 48 practical sessions (shifts), all put together to give you over 1000 hours of comprehensive training of the technical as well as the aesthetic aspects of film making, imparted by ZIMA's distinguished faculties.

During the course, the student will have to make 3 short films and on completion of the course, 1 final film/documentary.



PROGRAM IN DIRECTION

Course Duration: 6 Months

ZIMA's six month direction course contains all the essential ingredients required to make you a successful director of films and television.

This fast track course introduces you to the process of film making while the extensive practicals give you a hands on experience of what the real film / TV world holds in store for you.

Career:

After the completion of the Film & TV direction training the student can immediately take up the responsibility of directing a film or a television show. However, in order to gain the knowledge of the working conditions it is advisable that the student works as an assistant director in a production unit for some time. With the knowledge that our student carries with him, he becomes a big asset to any production unit he joins as an assistant director (AD).



ZIMA is today one of the better known acting schools in India where freshers and aspiring actors get trained under experts.


The conservatory programme prepares the student actor for the creative challenges of the actor's profession by providing the student with a solid craft that guarantees continued growth as a creative artist.

MANAGEMENT

The editor of a Film or TV show is responsible for imparting the right pitch, rhythm and tempo to the storytelling after the film or TV show has been shot. We at **ZIMA** impart to you balanced theoretical as well as practical Film & TV editing education under the supervision of working professional editors.



The course focuses on the practicals and aesthetics of Film & TV editing. The course is designed to teach the art and technique of Film and Video editing using FCP, AVID and Adobe Premier softwares, so the students can work as Independent Editors or Assistant Editors in the Film or Television industry.



SOUND RECORDING: WHAT IS IT?

There are several different types of sound recorders who specialize in different technical aspects of the job for recording and mixing. A sound recording is responsible for the digital audio workstation that record, edit, mix, manipulating the equalization, special effects the sound and reproduce the sound track, so they present the best performance consistent with the artist's vision. Also some recording end up designing and controlling the sound at films, in theaters, and in any other venue that requires sound projection for an audience. By controlling microphones, sound levels, and outputs, sound recorders combine their well-trained ears with their knowledge of acoustics to produce the best quality of sound for a variety of purpose.



A candidate will get 2 certificates; one is the course certificate for Sound Engineering Program and other will be the certificate for Steinberg software.
